### Frequently Asked Questions



**Q. How long is the Cosmetology program?**

**A. The Cosmetology Program is 1000 hours which is required by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Board of Cosmetology and Barbering.**

**Q. What will I learn in the Cosmetology program?**

**A. The Cosmetology curriculum is mandated by the Massachusetts Board of Cosmetology and Barbering, it is as follows:**

**Hours Subjects for Cosmetology Program**

50	Manicure (12.5 hours of Artificial Nail Technique)
250	Hair Straightening & Permanent Waving
25	Shampooing
50	Finger Waving
80	Skin Care/Make-up/Facial Grooming
50	Wig Instruction and Scalp Treatment
150	Coloring – Dyes and Bleaching
125	Haircutting
125	Oral, Written, and Practical Tests: Sterilization, Hygiene, and Anatomy
25	Ethics, Salesmanship, Courtesy, & Conduct
25	Instruction and Lecture on Sanitation
45	<u>Marcelling and all Iron Curls</u>
1000	Total Hours

**Q. Must all Massachusetts Cosmetology Schools offer the required curriculum?**

**A. Yes.**

**Q. Why is this so important?**

**A. The State License Exam is based on the required curriculum. Passing the Massachusetts Cosmetology State Board Exam depends on it!**

**Q. How long will it take to complete the 1000 hour program.**

**A. Full time will take 9 months. The length of the program will be based on the number of hours you are attending per week. The more hours you attend per week the faster you will complete the program.**

**Q. What program schedules are available?**

**A. Classes are Monday through Friday. We offer full time and part-time schedules. In our Quincy location we offer an evening program: Monday, Tuesday and Thursday evening. Please contact the school for more information on schedules.**

**Q. What is the total cost of the program?**

**A. The total cost of the program is as follows:**

Tuition:	\$ 11,900.00
Registration fee:	50.00
Kit, Books, Supplies:	950.00
Tax:	30.00
Lab Coat	30.00

**Q. Does Mansfield Beauty Schools offer Financial Aid?**

**A. Yes, Mansfield Beauty Schools' students are eligible to apply for:**

- Mansfield Beauty Schools Tuition Payment Plan that has "NO" interest fees or finance charges.

**Note: There are Industry Scholarships you may also be eligible for. They are very limited. We are happy to provide additional information.**

**Q. What is this the difference in Cosmetology Schools?**

**A. We recommend that you:**

- Compare the history and experience of the School
- Compare the cost of tuition and supplies remember all schools must offer the same curriculum.
- Make sure the school is licensed and accredited.
- Make sure you have received an estimated Financial Aid Award package before you enrollment
- Make sure you know what portion of your financial aid is loans what portion is grants.
- Does the school charge Interest and or Finance Fees on in school tuition payments?
- Does the school charge a late fee if you are late on a payment while you are in school?
- Does the school offer changes of enrollment schedules.
- Visit the school, choose where you feel most comfortable.
